PARKING Please use our visitor car park at the far side of the barns if your group has more than 5 cars. We have electric car charging bays in the visitor car park.


If coming by train, the nearest station is Royston (with taxi rank). It is advisable to book taxis in advance.

Check-in & Check-Out
Check in from 4pm, check out by 10am.
Keys are in the lockbox in the entrance
porch. You will recieve a unique code via
email to access the lockbox.

Heating Instructions: The thermostat for the whole house is located in the bar area. Please do not adjust individual radiators.

Wood Burning Stove: Please use 1 firelighting log and 2 small wooden logs to start a fire. The stove door must stay shut with the handle closed at all times apart from when lighting or adding a log. Lighters/matches are in the boot room drawers, please return after each use and do not leave near a heat source. Coffee: We provide stovetop coffee makers, cafetières, and premium ground coffee.

BBQ: The Weber BBQ is located at the front of the house. The first bag of charcoal is provided, thereafter please supply your own. NB Please DO NOT use logs on the BBQ.

Before you leave: Please leave the property tide, remove any food items you have bought with you and take all rubbish out to the bins- you'll find these to the right of the porch. Please wash up everything you have used in the kitchen and put away.

Remember to log out of any apps you may have used on the TV.

Please lock the property/properties and place the key back in the lockbox


